

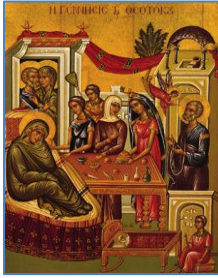

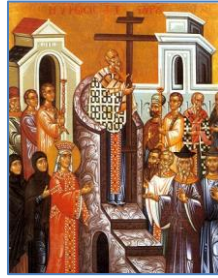

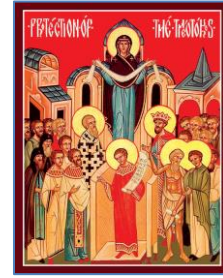

Great Vespers:
