

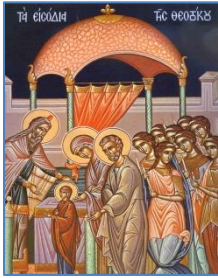

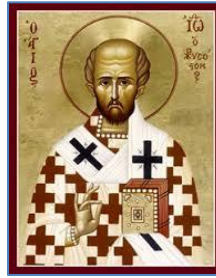

“RAISING THE RULER'S DAUGHTER: DEATH WAS, FROM THAT TIME FORWARD, A SLEEP

“Now all wept and mourned for her, but He said, ‘Do not weep; she is not dead, but sleeping.’ And they laughed Him to scorn, knowing that she was dead. But He put them all out, took her by the hand and called saying, ‘Little girl, arise.’ Then her spirit returned, and she arose immediately. And He commanded that she be given something to eat.” Luke 8:52-55

Commentary: ‘Before her resurrection, He raises her in His words, saying, ‘The maid is not dead, but sleeping.’ And with...respect to Lazarus also, He says, ‘Our friend Lazarus is sleeping’ (Jn.11:11)...He is teaching us not to fear death: for that it is not death, but has henceforth become a sleep...Let no man therefore torture himself any further, nor wait, nor disparage Christ's achievement. For indeed He overcame death. Why then do you wait for nothing? Henceforth it is now a sleep.’ St. John Chrysostom

 - 2) Confess sometime during this season
 - 3) Keep the fast as best you can
 - 4) Do these things in order prepare for the feasts of the appearing of the Lord, the birth and the Baptism of Christ
